# Local officials take action against human services cuts, call center plan

**T**SEU members are meeting with city and county officials to discuss the effects of HB 2292. Elected leaders are reacting with anger as they learn the Legislature is attempting to balance its budget by passing responsibilities on to them while cutting resources

available to local governments. On top of drastic cuts in state funds, cities and counties might be saddled with increased hospital costs as Medicaid and CHIP are cut. Additional strain is put on communities where DHS offices, MHMR facilities, or both might be closed.
